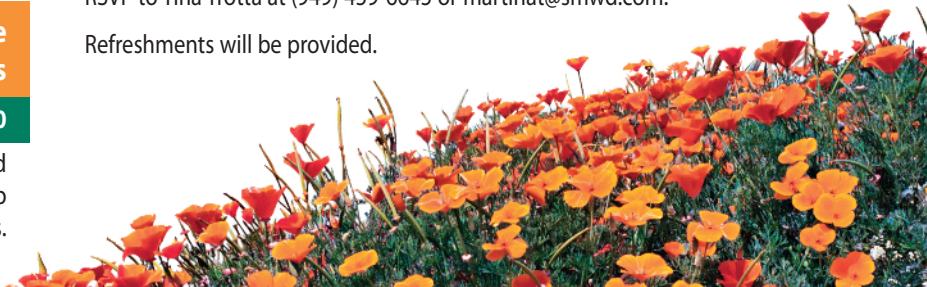
# Free Home Gardeners Workshops
